Responsibilities include but not limited to:

- Providing case management services
- Providing crisis intervention and de-escalation techniques with consumers
- Referring consumers to community programs/services and conducts follow-up as necessary
- Performing a bio/psycho/social assessment of consumer's mental and physical health, diagnosing and evaluating their substance abuse treatment needs, situation, concerns, and barriers to accessing services
- Formulating individualized consumers centered treatment plans in collaboration with the consumers and consumer's designated support system
- Monitoring, updates and modifies treatment plan as necessary, to be consistent with consumer's needs and/or conditions
- Performing individual, group and family counseling
- Conducting on site drug testing and interprets urine drug screening results from lab
- Compiling consumer records and maintains documentation according to program and accreditation standards and protocols
- Maintaining confidentiality, respect consumer's privacy, routine, and independence as much as possible
- May be required to play an active role in the event of a public health emergency, which may include changes in responsibilities and working hours
