- Implementation of sexual health interventions

- Conducting HIV pre-test and post-test counseling and interventions for clients and their sexual partners who may be at increased risk for HIV infections, including providing educational, behavioral, and risk reduction information
- Performing finger sticks for rapid HIV, Hepatitis C and syphilis testing
- Providing referrals as needed for medical, social services and psychological follow-up
- Addresses public's requests for HIV/AIDS information through group presentations, TV, radio, and printed materials
- Developing needs assessment by maintaining relationships with external agencies to identify HIV/AIDS education programs, share resources, and locate services for clientele
- Interacting with staff on HIV/AIDS related programs with emphasis on reducing the spread of HIV in Montgomery County and the surrounding communities in region 9 (Clark, Darke, Greene, Miami, and Preble counties)
- Clerical duties which include data entry for Electronic Medical Records (EMR) and completing reports
- May be required to play an active role in the event of a public health emergency, which may include changes in responsibilities and working hours
