- Bachelor of Science in Nursing Degree plus four years' experience in nursing (two of which are in Public Health) or an Associate Degree with six years of nursing experience (two of which are in Public Health)

Responsibilities include but not limited to:

- Responsible for assisting the physician with medical evaluations for various populations including refugees/immigrants/foreign-born and other high-risk populations.
- Responsible for assisting the physician with medical evaluations.

- Recording patient care and progress regularly
