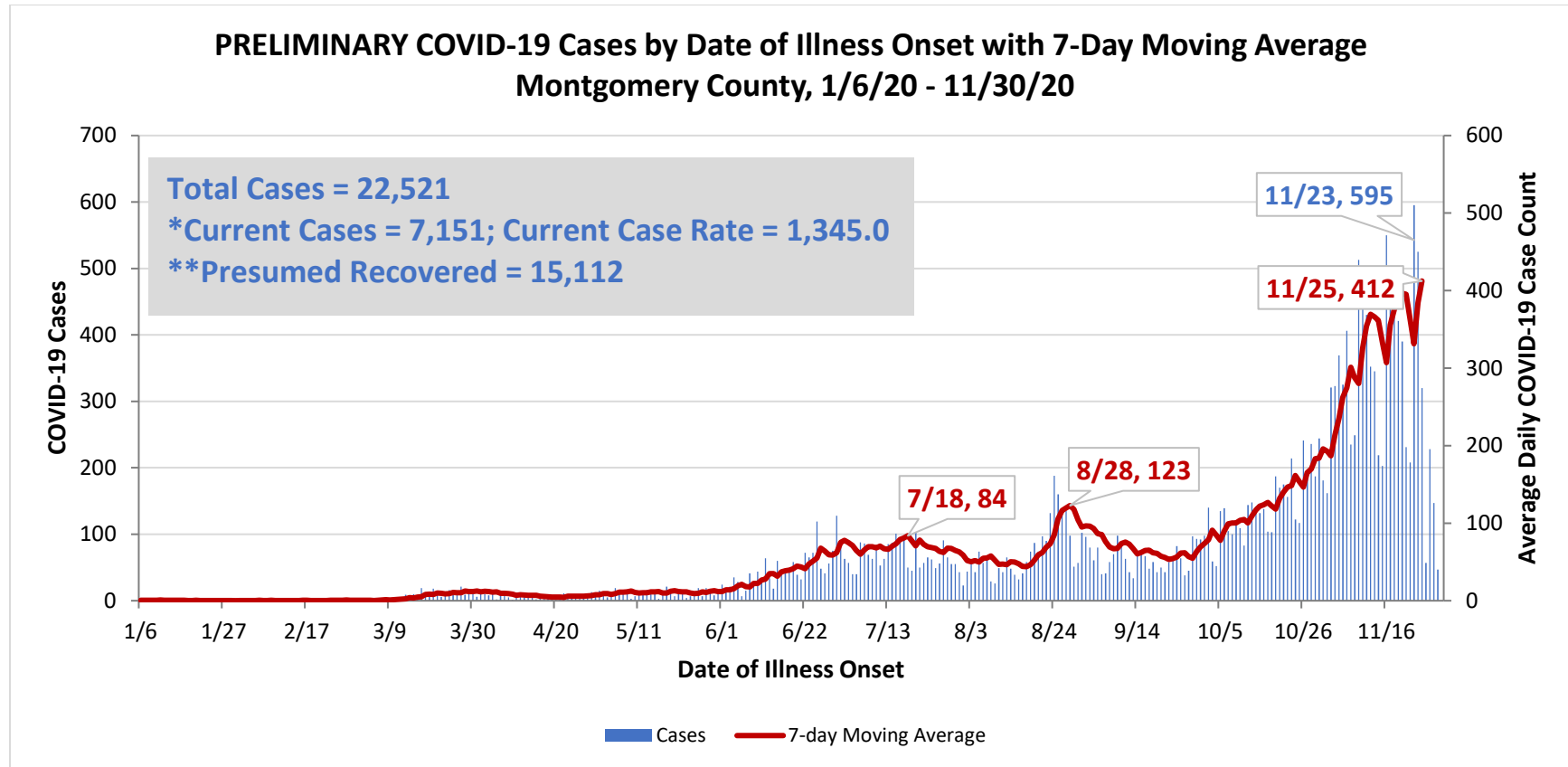




## Montgomery County COVID-19 Cases As of 11/30/20

### Key Points:

- Montgomery County’s average daily COVID-19 case count was the highest it has been on 11/25/20 (412 cases per day).
- The highest incidence in reported COVID-19 cases occurred on 11/23/20 (595 cases).
- The current case rate increased 6% in the past two weeks from 1,268 (on 11/16) to 1,345 cases per 100,000 (on 11/30), indicating increased community spread.

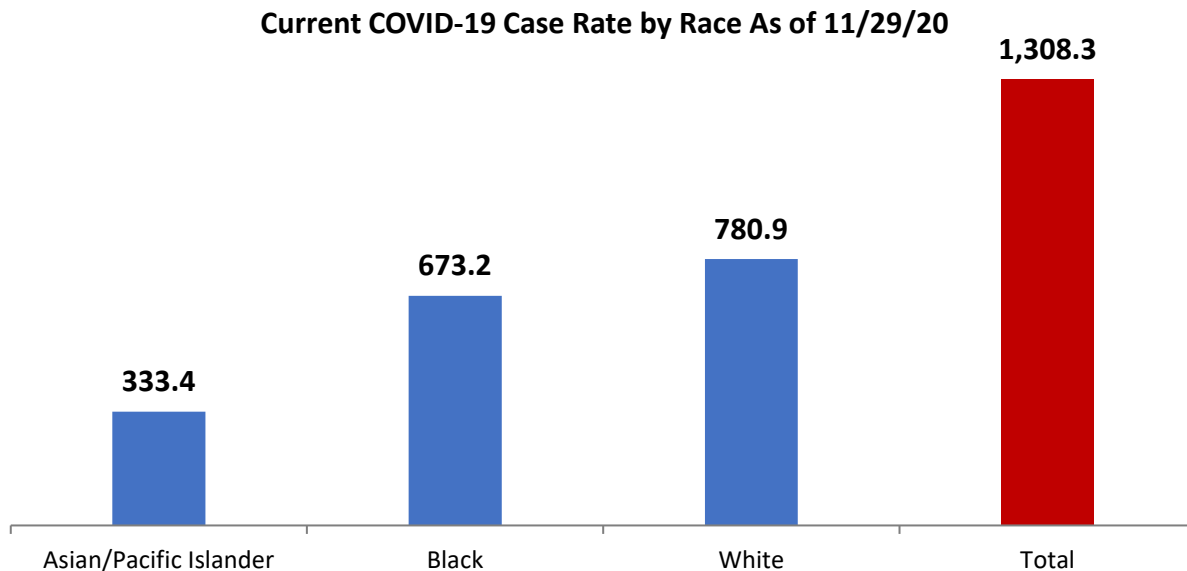
**Montgomery County COVID-19 Outbreak and School Data:**

- Montgomery County currently has 88 COVID-19 outbreak investigations open at various long-term care facilities, businesses, and schools.
- Eleven outbreak investigations have opened in the past three weeks – 2 (18%) schools, 7 (64%) long-term care facilities, and 2 business (18%).
- Of the 6,956 current cases, only 10% (672 cases) have been linked to an outbreak – indicating that most of the recent spread of COVID-19 has occurred in the community and not within institutions.
- Montgomery County has a total of 786 cases associated with schools (442 students, 344 staff). Of the 786 cases, 29% (230 cases – 161 students, 69 staff) were reported in the past week.

**Key Points:**

- Whites have the highest current case rate (780.9) and the highest number of current cases (3,081 cases).
- Blacks have the highest overall case rate (3,509.2).
- Race is unknown for 22% of total cases and 36% of current cases.

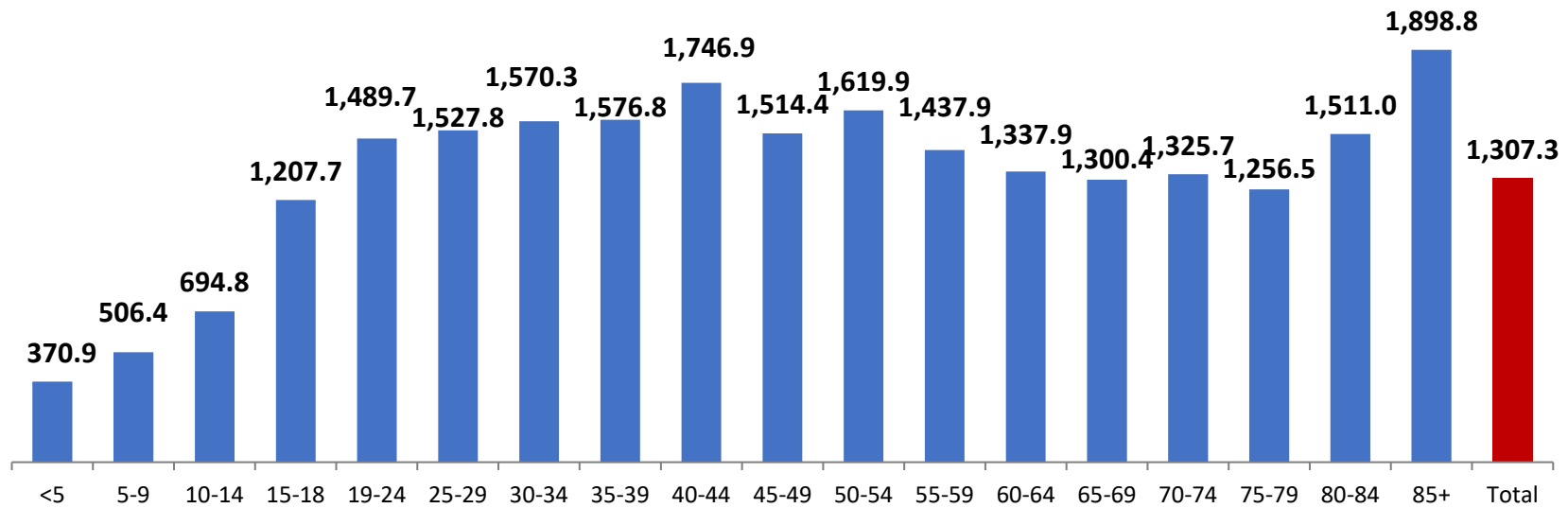

**Key Points:**

- The age group 85 years and older has the highest current case rate in Montgomery County (1,898.8), but the highest overall rate is among 19-24-year-olds (7,056.3).
- The highest number and percentage of hospitalizations occurred among 70-79-year-olds (479 hospitalizations; 24% of hospitalizations).
- Individuals 80 years and older account for less than 6% of total cases but 42% of total deaths due to COVID-19.
