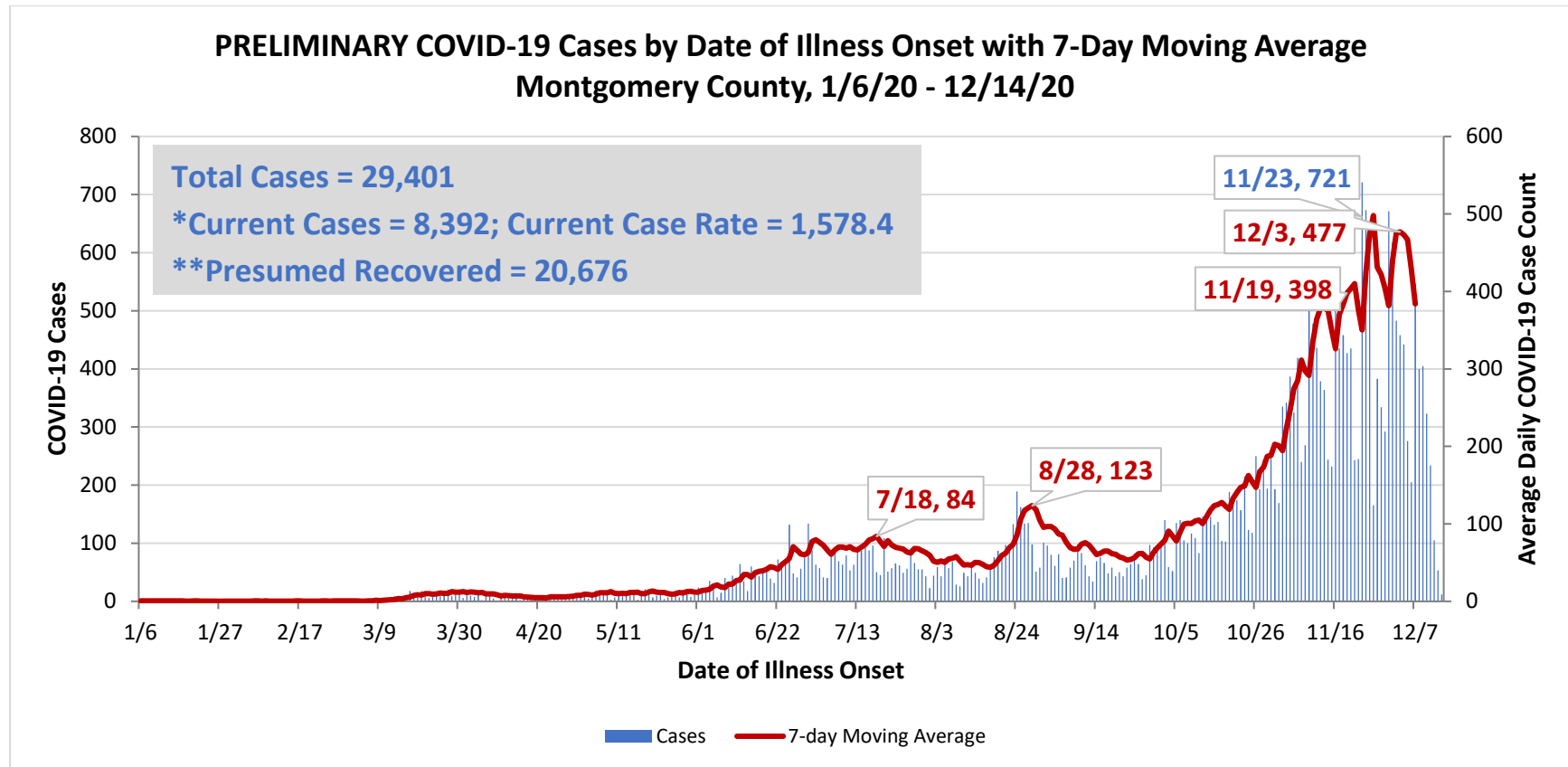


Montgomery County COVID-19 Cases As of 12/14/20

Key Points:

- Montgomery County's average daily COVID-19 case count was the second highest it has been on 12/3/20 (477 cases per day).
- The highest incidence in reported COVID-19 cases occurred on 11/23/20 (721 cases).
- The most recent COVID-19 data are incomplete due to a large volume of cases that are pending review. The true number of current cases is likely higher.

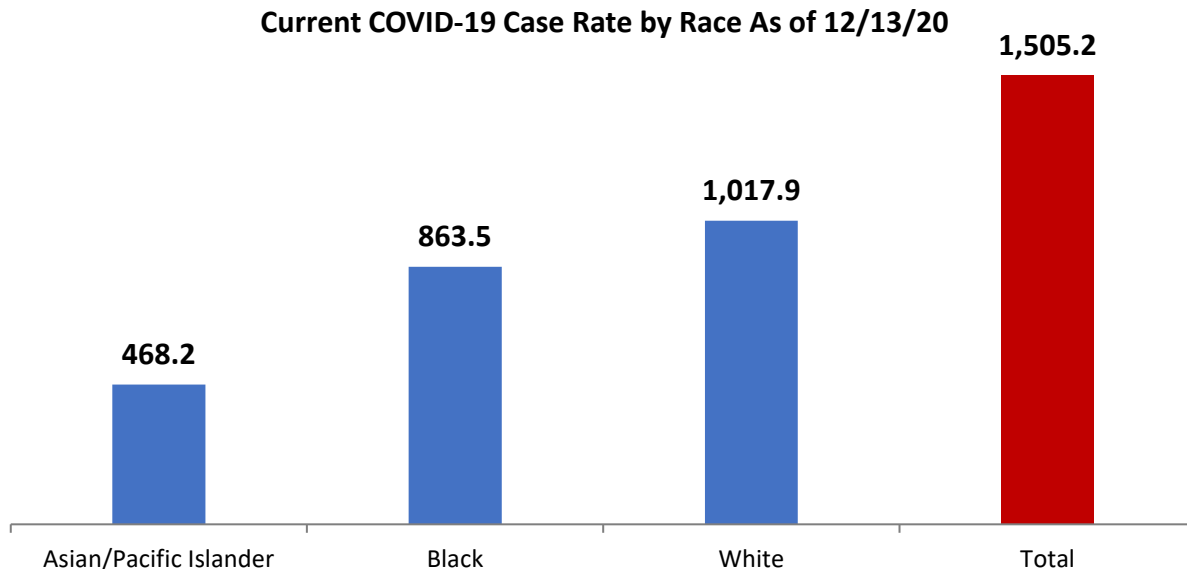
Montgomery County COVID-19 Outbreak and School Data:

- Montgomery County currently has 101 COVID-19 outbreak investigations open at various long-term care facilities, businesses, and schools.
- Seventeen (17) outbreak investigations have opened in the past three weeks – 10 (59%) long-term care facilities, 3 (18%) healthcare/treatment facilities, 1 (6%) business, 1 (6%) homeless shelter, 1 (6%) fire department, and 1 (6%) correctional institution.
- Of the 8,003 current cases, only 11% (887 cases) have been linked to an outbreak – indicating that most of the recent spread of COVID-19 has occurred in the community and not within institutions.
- Montgomery County has a total of 1,078 cases associated with schools (612 students, 466 staff). Of the 1,078 cases, 16% (174 cases – 97 students, 77 staff) were reported in the past week.

Key Points:

- Whites have the highest current case rate (1,017.9) and the highest number of current cases (4,016 cases).
- Blacks have the highest overall case rate (4,390.0).
- Race is unknown for 22% of total cases and 30% of current cases.

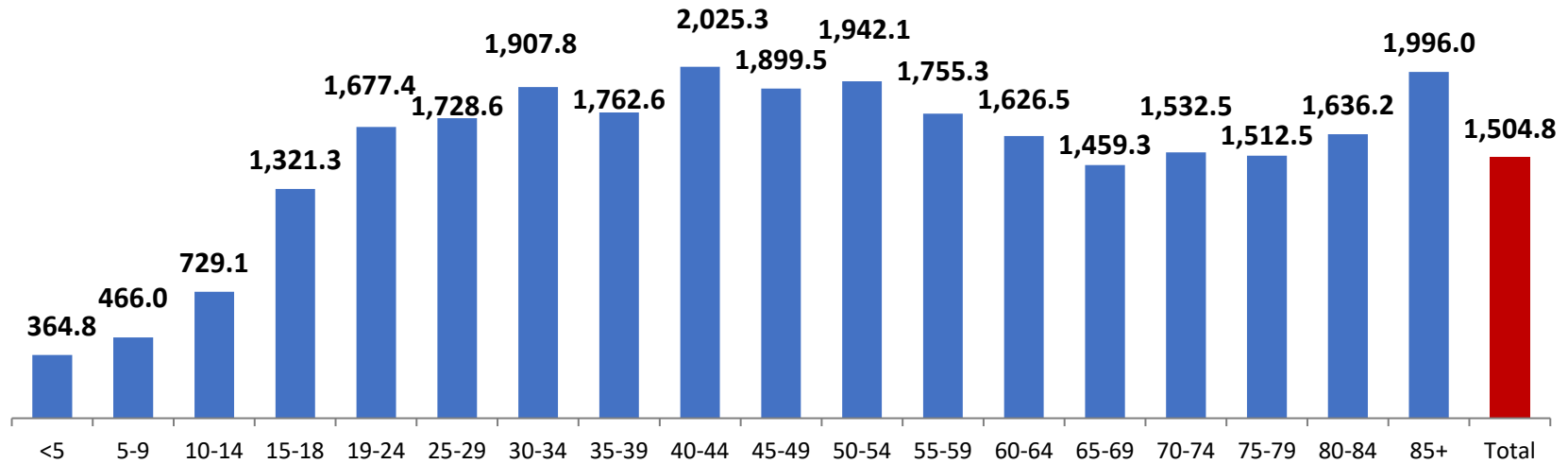

Key Points:

- The age group 40-44 years has the highest current case rate in Montgomery County (2,025.3), but the highest overall rate is among 19-24-year-olds (8,491.3).
- The highest number and percentage of hospitalizations occurred among 70-79-year-olds (604 hospitalizations; 24% of hospitalizations).
- Individuals 80 years and older account for less than 6% of total cases but 43% of total deaths due to COVID-19.
