



## Montgomery County COVID-19 Summary as of 1/29/2021

### Overall:

- **The current case rate dropped 28% compared to last week (from 1,190 to 851 current cases per 100,000).**
- Montgomery County's average daily COVID-19 case count has dropped 32% in the past two weeks (from 373 cases per day on 1/8/21 to 253 cases per day on 1/22/21).

### Montgomery County COVID-19 Outbreak and School Data:

- Montgomery County currently has 129 COVID-19 outbreak investigations open at various long-term care facilities, businesses, and schools.
- Fourteen (14) outbreak investigations have opened in the past week – 7 (50%) businesses, 6 (43%) schools/daycares, and 1 (7%) healthcare facility.
- Montgomery County has a total of 1,776 cases associated with schools (1,012 students, 764 staff). **Of the 1,776 cases, 7% (125 cases – 87 students, 38 staff) were reported in the past week, a 57% increase from last week.**

### Demographics:

- Whites have the highest current case rate (663.3) and the highest number of current cases (2,617 cases).
- Whites have the highest overall rate (6,393.3).
- **Race is unknown for 18% of total cases and 20% of current cases.**
- The age group 85 years and older has the highest current rate (1,255.9).
- 19-24-year-olds have the highest overall rate (12,135.9).
- Individuals 70 years and older account for 14% of total cases, 45% of total hospitalizations, and 71% of total deaths.
