



Montgomery County COVID-19 Summary as of 2/26/2021

Overall:

- **The current case rate (per 100,000) dropped 32% in the last week (from 419 on 2/19/21 to 284 on 2/26/21).**
- Montgomery County's average daily COVID-19 case count has dropped 22% in the past week (from 101 cases per day on 2/13/21 to 79 cases per day on 2/26/21).

Montgomery County COVID-19 Outbreak and School Data:

- Montgomery County currently has 182 COVID-19 outbreak investigations open at various long-term care facilities, businesses, and schools.
- **Zero outbreak investigations opened in the past week.**
- Montgomery County has a total of 2,174 cases associated with schools (1,275 students, 899 staff). **Of the 2,174 cases, 2% (46 cases – 36 students, 10 staff) were reported in the past week, a 43% decrease from last week.**

Demographics:

- Whites have the highest current case rate (252.4) and the highest number of current cases (996 cases), **a 24% decrease in the last week (334.3; 1,319).**
- Whites have the highest overall rate (6,974.7).
- **Race is unknown for 17% of total cases and 11% of current cases.**
- The age group 50-54 years has the highest current rate (430.5).
- Individuals 70 years and older account for 13% of total cases, 45% of total hospitalizations, and 76% of total deaths.
