Data Branch
Coordinate collection of birth outcome and intervention initiatives data.

Prevention and Healthy Birth
Reduce unintended pregnancy, prepare for planned pregnancy and decrease the percentage of preterm and low birth weight babies.

Ohio Equity Institute / Medicaid
Support the statewide initiatives to improve birth outcomes and reduce racial disparities in infant mortality.

Case Review Team and Community Action Team
Review and analyze the information collected in interviews and medical data abstractions.

Safe Sleep
Increase knowledge, awareness and training on the ABCs of safe sleep for babies.

Substance Misuse
Reduce the number of mothers who use tobacco and/or marijuana and increase awareness and utilization of SBIRT model.

Community Engagement
Collaborate with community members affiliated by geographic area to implement effective place-based initiatives.

Breastfeeding
Offer support, education and resources for breastfeeding mothers and encourage breastfeeding as the optimal health and nutrition option.

Incorporate the experiences of medical professionals to positively impact physical and emotional maternal health
